

Solid Waste Management

Dustbins are located on various floors at various locations such as classrooms, library, staffroom, admin office etc. This separated waste is then collected by the corporation garbage collecting van outside the Institute campus. Other solid waste such as old newspapers, old journal volumes, outdated brochures etc. are sold to scrap vendor.
